Investments **include** real estate (excluding the home you live in), trust funds, UGMA and UTMA accounts, money market funds, mutual funds, certificates of deposit, stocks, stock options, bonds, other securities, Coverdell savings accounts, 529 college savings plans, the refund value of 529 state prepaid tuition plans, installment and land sale contracts (including mortgages held), commodities, etc.

Investment value includes the market value of these investments as of the date the financial aid application was completed. (The date you originally completed the application appears on the Asset Follow Up Notification email recently sent to you.)

Investment debt means only those debts that are related to the investments. Investments **do not** include the home you live in, the value of life insurance, retirement plans (pension funds, annuities, non-education IRAs, Keogh plans, etc.) or cash, savings, and checking accounts already reported in Section 1 of this form.
