The 12-consecutive month period begins on the first day of classes for which the student first receives financial aid with this status at any school. Once the 12-consecutive month period has elapsed, students are no longer eligible for further financial aid, unless admitted to a new eligible program.

At Sonoma State University, the Federal Direct Loan program is the only type of financial aid available for students completing prerequisites.
